Segun Kuteyi was appointed the managing director of Chevron China and head of the China business unit on August 1, 2022. As the President of Chevron China Energy Company Pte. Ltd. and Unocal East China Sea Ltd., Segun leads Chevron's value-chain business strategies in China, partnering with all stakeholders, based on Chevron's proud legacy position that began more than a century ago, to provide affordable, reliable, and ever-cleaner energy to drive human progress and support transition to a low-carbon future.

Prior to his current role, Segun was the general manager of operations for Chevron Pipeline & Power (CPP) in the United States. He managed CPP's pipeline, terminal and export operations spanning nearly 3,000 miles, as well as conventional and renewable power assets across seven U.S. states of Texas, Louisiana, California, Utah, Colorado, Wyoming and New Mexico. He served on the API-AOPL performance excellence team and the API low carbon energy infrastructure subcommittee (LCEIS), comprising senior cross-functional managers of US energy companies. In the course of his career, Segun has been representing Chevron's interests as president, officer and/or board member on US-based, China-based and Nigeria-based companies/entities.

Segun joined Chevron in 1996 as a plant/process engineer and has served in several leadership positions of increasing responsibility in Nigeria, USA and now in China, within operations, facilities engineering, project management, as well as extensive cross-functional experience as manager, strategy and business planning; manager onshore assets within the asset development group; and commercial, marketing and business development role as general manager, downstream gas.

A Fellow of the Nigerian Society of Engineers (NSE), a senior member of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) and a long-standing member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE), Segun graduated from Nigerian universities with a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering (1994) and a master's degree in engineering management (2000).
